Applicants must have completed school-based practicum (student teaching), and must obtain full-time employment in the Ohio schools for the 2011-12 academic year no later than November 1, 2011. Employees contracted by private agencies or those who have received financial compensation through the OMNIE SLP Intern graduate program option are not eligible for the \$5,000 tuition reimbursement incentive.
